SOME HOUSING

The market is in a sort of pause. Homes are still selling and prices are mostly inching up, but growth has slowed.

Mortgage rates recently eased a bit and average 30-year fixed loans are around 6.3-6.4%, which is nudging some buyers back into the market. Because rates and buyer demand are still relatively high, many sellers are lowering prices or sitting tight rather than chasing aggressive offers. Next year rates are expected to continue a slow decline while sales and prices slowly increase.
